Each participant will be interviewed for acceptance into the training program.

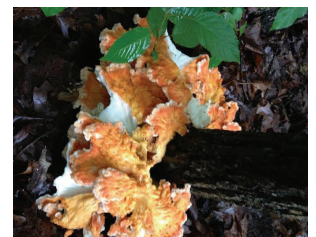
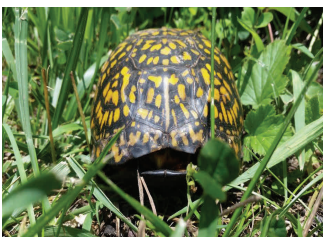
To become a Master Naturalist, one must:

- Complete 60 hours of Master Naturalist training
- Share hands-on activities and field studies
- Participate in a group project or individual presentation
- Volunteer 40 hours of service to CVP or MPNC within the first year

The cost for the course is \$250 and is limited to 25 students (18 years and older).

The fee covers the cost of a Master Naturalist Manual, publications, and general supplies.

Upon completion of the course, and initial service hours at the nature center, participants will be certified Master Naturalists.
