



2023 MPNCC Spring Scholarship Application

The Marshy Point Nature Center Council will award three \$1,000.00 scholarships for the 2023 Spring Semester. Eligible applicants include college freshmen, sophomores, and first-time students entering as a Junior. Applicants must show a high level of commitment to conservation through occupational, educational, and personal experiences. Application must be submitted no later than **January 1, 2023**.

Eligibility Guidelines

The Council uses the following criteria as a baseline for their review process:

1. 3.0 minimum GPA
2. Freshman, sophomore, of first-time student entering as a Junior (transfer student)
3. Environmental Science or related major
4. Nature/conservation-based volunteer or work experience

As a nonprofit organization based on equity and accessibility, the Council encourages applicants who do not meet the above criteria due to limitations or barriers to still apply. Applicants do not need to include documentation of the limitations or barriers but are welcome to highlight additional experiences relating to conservation and nature.
